### Competition Rules and Format

#### 1. Introduction

The Perth Bear community through Bears Perth Inc. is searching for a person to represent Bears Perth Inc. in the coming year, and Perth's contribution to the Mr Australasia Bear Festival. The title holder will represent our State in the Mr. Australasia Bear 2022 competition in June 2022 (*if held*).

This competition is not to find the most attractive, large, muscled or most hairy bear. It is to find the man that most typifies what a bear is in today's ever-changing world. Someone who can uphold the values of self-confidence, masculinity, understanding and inclusiveness.

The title holder is expected to be an ambassador for the Bear community, promote a positive bear image, foster unity within the bear culture and be a role model for those new to the community. He must maintain an openness, respect, and willingness to work with all aspects of the LGBTIQ and wider communities.

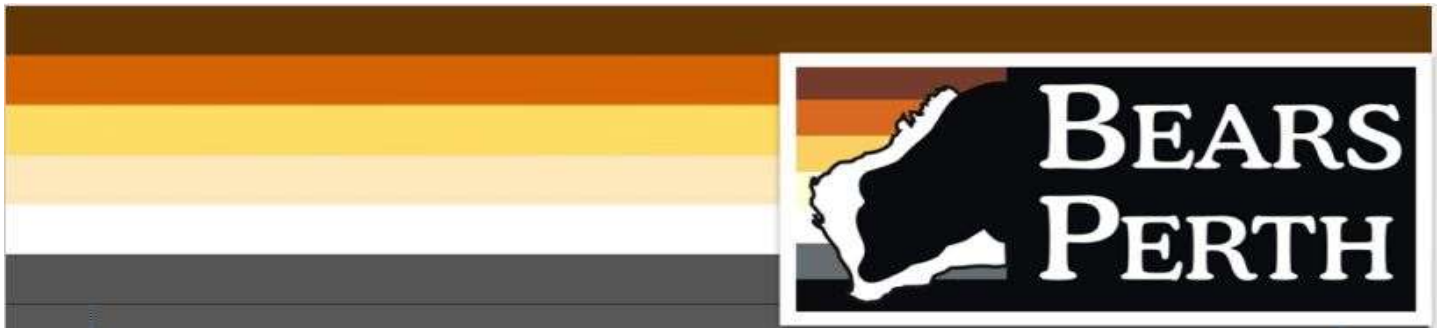

## **2. Rules and format of the Competition**

Contestants are expected to participate fully in all the events listed below, failure to do so may render the contestant ineligible to continue in the competition.

*Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> November 8pm onwards at Perth Steamworks, Northbridge.*

This is one of Bears Perth Inc. highlight parties and is always busy and vibrant.

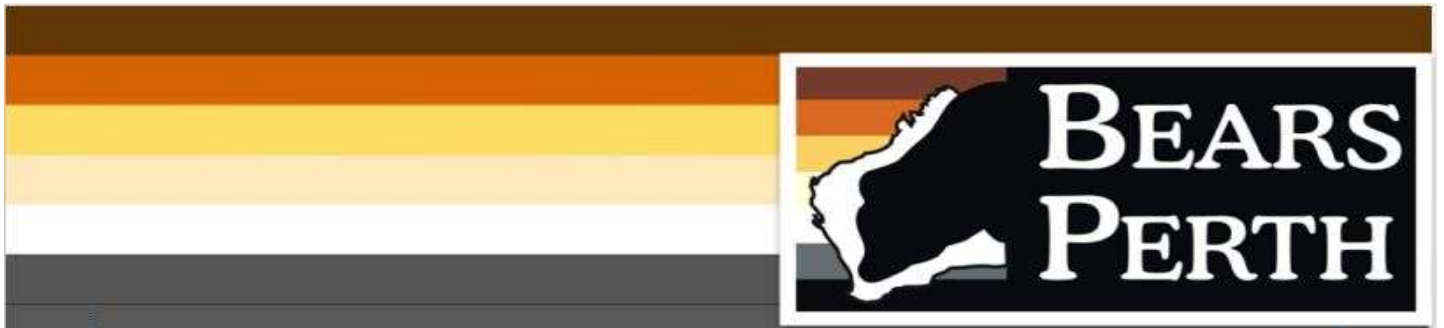
- Contestant's will be introduced to the members and engage in fundraising for the chosen beneficiary
- Contestants need to undertake the theme to this party and wear underwear which most captures their individuality, and helps them make an impression on the crowd
- The judges will also be announced at this time

*This is your chance to make a lasting and first impression on the Members and the Judges!*

- **Bingay – Drag Bingo**  
*Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> November 8pm at Connections Nightclub*
  - Contestants will be ball announcers during the night and mingle with guests
- **Bear Perth Black Tie Ball**  
*Friday 12<sup>th</sup> November (time TBC) at The Doubletree Hotel Executive Lounge, Northbridge*
  - Contestants will mingle with guests
- **Mr Bear Perth 2021 Interview Round**  
*Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> November 10am sharp at Connections Nightclub*

- The interview will last about 10 minutes and will represent 40% of the total score
- The judges will score your performance solely on your answers and not on physical attributes or attire
- Your interview is not open to the public, other contestants or your family and friends

*This is a chance behind closed doors and without distractions to show the judges your qualities!*

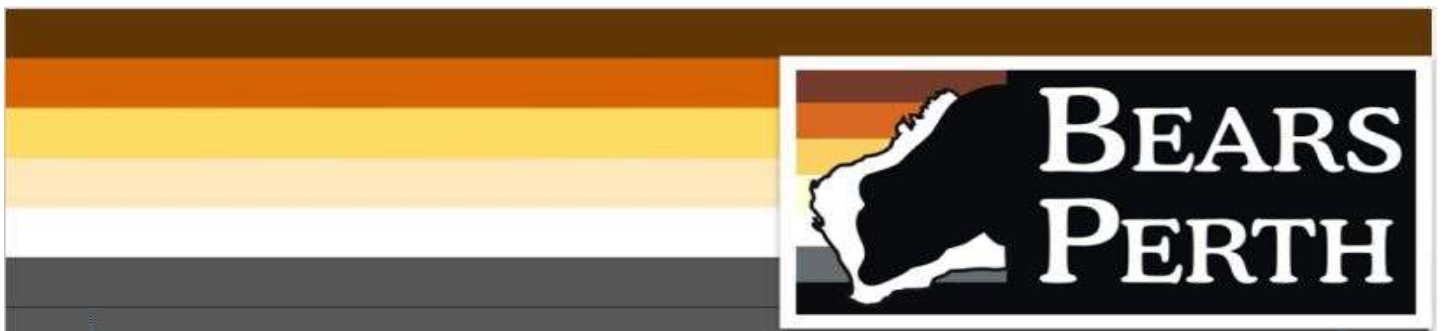
*Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> November following the Interview Round at Connections Nightclub*

- Your chance to familiarise yourself with the backstage areas of the venue and help with any uncertainty about being on stage under all the lights
- Important for the Connections techs to iron out any logistical issues with your fantasy round

Please bring any props, sets or music/visuals you will require for Saturday night's fantasy round.

Music/sound/visuals for your fantasy round must be supplied on a USB or CD disc (Mobile phones, laptops or tablets will NOT be accepted). We highly recommend contestants bring a backup of any audio/visual devices as a precaution.

The Connections crew need to organise this before the competition that evening. If you do not supply any of these items at this time, we cannot guarantee a smooth fantasy performance for you.



- **Mr Bear Perth 2020 Competition at Connections Nightclub**  
*Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> November 7pm – 12am - MEN ONLY*

The purpose of this event in the Competition is the presentation of your physique, stage presence, and public speaking ability to the judges and the audience.

- This event is **open to the public**
- You must bring all your stage attire to this event
- You are limited to 1 friend/ helper backstage for the fantasy round only
- You will always be looked after throughout the competition backstage by Connections staff
- There will be an intermission following round 2

### **Round 1: Work Wear/Day Wear (20% of score)**

This is the judges and audience's first chance to get to know you, so give the best impression you can and be yourself. Wear what you wear to work or during a regular day!

As your name is announced you walk on stage and meet the hosts who will ask you several questions. You will then parade along the stage and head back to the dressing room.

Once all contestants complete this round, a short 5-minute break in the contest will occur so that you can change attire for the next round. Contestants remain in the dressing room during this break.

### **Round 2. Bear Minimum (20% of score)**

You are expected to dress in the minimum you believe shows your physique to full advantage.

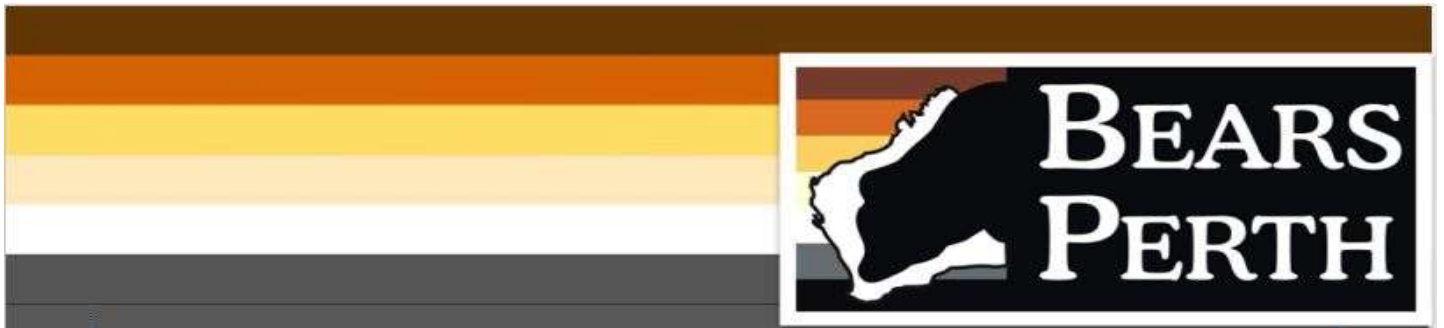
Again, as your name is called you proceed to the hosts to be asked a question and possible follow-up questions. Once have answered the question/s, you will have 30 seconds to parade the stage and show the judges and audience what you've got!

### **Round 3. Fantasy Section (20% of score)**

For this round you will be expected to show the judges and audience a special fantasy of your own. This could be a sexual fantasy, a lifelong fantasy or a situation you would love to find yourself in.

This round gives you the greatest amount of freedom to show the judges a deeper or more fun side of your personality.

You may use a friend/helper for this round as part of your performance. All technical requirements (music & audio/visual/sets/props) should have been supplied at the interview round.



### **3. Announcement of Mr. Bear Perth, and 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> runners up**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> runners up will be announced in succession before the winner is announced.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> runner up will receive their trophy and

The 1<sup>st</sup> runner up will receive their trophy and

The **Winner of Mr. Bear Perth 2021** will receive their trophy and

- Flights to Melbourne to compete in Mr Australasia Bear 2022; and
- Accommodation in Melbourne courtesy of Bears Perth.

The winner will also receive -

The winner will be presented with the Mr. Bear Perth 2021 winner's sash courtesy of Eagle Leather. The winner will be able to permanently retain this sash upon successful completion of their Year as Mr. Bear Perth.
